**ONLINE ARTIST IN RESIDENCE HANNAH TARDIE  
DEVELOPS SERIES OF PLASTER AND FOUND OBJECT  
SCULPTURES FOR VIRTUAL EXHIBITION**

October 2020, Astoria, New York - AlterWork Studios is pleased to present the work of Hannah Tardie in the form of a virtual exhibition. The exhibition, entitled “My House”, marks the completion of Hannah’s 4-week online residency with the studio. The exhibit will be available for viewing on the studio’s website from October 24, 2020 through November 14, 2020.



“My House” is a series of works that explores the boundaries between the artist’s body and different domestic objects while being confined to the house in quarantine. The works are made by combining plaster and readymade objects as an exploration of the rigidness of objects and their functional categories. The works are meant to examine these functional categories, carefully looking for humor, abundance, and grief in their dysfunction.

Hannah Tardie is a sculptor, performer, and installation artist who was born in Orange, California. She recently completed a graduate degree in electronic arts from New York University, where she was awarded the Red Burns Scholarship and a Tisch School of the Arts scholarship. Tardie’s work examines intimacy, gender, and rituals of the everyday. She currently lives and works in Brooklyn, New York.
