

ASTORIA BASED ART STUDIO PRESENTS VIRTUAL EXHIBIT EXPLORING SOLIDARITY IN A POST-COVID WORLD

New York City, August 27, 2020 - The curatorial team at AlterWork Studios presents their latest online exhibition, Solidarity: International. This is Part 1 of their Virus of Dehumanization programming, a three part series of exhibitions and discussions aimed at a deeper understanding of the world we currently live in and a quest for a better one. Covid-19 has revealed and exacerbated global, structural inequities, and shown just how far world leaders have fallen short. For Part 1, Solidarity: International, they explore how thinking as global citizens might help us build social contracts



and global communities amongst ourselves that are empathetic, equitable, just and effective.

"The devastation that Covid-19 has wrecked upon vulnerable populations, not just here in NYC, but globally, has really brought to the forefront a grim pattern of worsening conditions and eroding personal freedoms and human rights; we wanted to use the platform of Alterwork Studios to not just highlight this fact, but to come together as a global community and try to find solutions." ~ Curatorial Team
